- It's sometimes easy to think that people are the worst, everything is terrible, and what's the point?
- "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people." | Luke 2, v.10

- Happiness is shallow. Joy is deep. Happiness is short-term. Joy is long-term. Happiness comes and goes. Joy lasts. Happiness is like a light switch, on and off. Joy is chosen, developed, and practiced. Happiness reacts. Joy transcends.
- Though you have not seen [Christ], you love him; and even though you do not see him now, you believe in him and are filled with an inexpressible and glorious joy... | 1 Peter 1, v.8
- ...for a little while you may have had to suffer grief in all kinds of trials. | 1 Peter 1, v.6
- Experiencing true joy often goes hand-in-hand with suffering.
- People are the worst, everything is terrible, what's the point—that's one story you can believe.
- What story will you choose to believe?
- The story you choose to believe is the story you will write.
- When we believe a story, it has ripple effects and consequences.
- You can believe that there is no good, no evil, no justice. That has consequences.
- You can believe the story of Jesus. It's a story of hope.

Christians find compelling evidence, in the story of Jesus, that Jesus, with great persistence and great vulnerability, everywhere he went, turned the enmity of society toward a new possibility, turned the sadness of the world toward joy, introduced a new regime where the dead are raised, the lost are found, and the displaced are brought home again." | Walter Brueggeman
- If you believe the story of Jesus, you get to write a better story with your life.
- Great hope leads to great joy.
