- The followers of Jesus who discover an empty tomb find so much more than what they were looking for.
- Then the men asked, "Why are you looking among the dead for someone who is alive? | Luke 24, v.5
- Where am I looking for life in dead things and dead ends?
- There are so many things we use to try to find life, but they can't do what Jesus did, and they can't offer what Jesus does.
- I have come that they may have life, and life to the full. | John 10, v.10
- We've all looked for life in dead places. Jesus offers real life, in every way.
